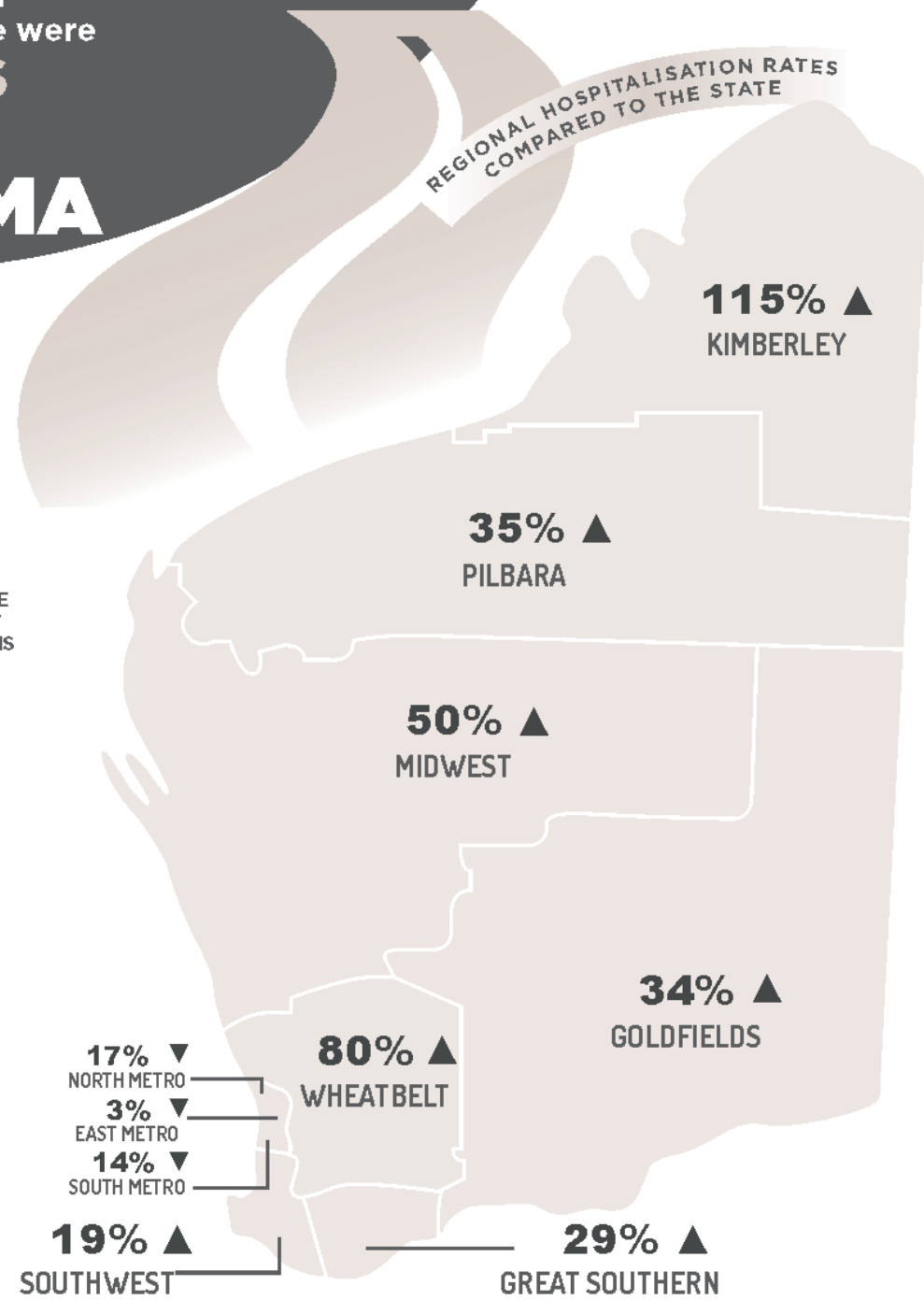
FOCUS

In Western Australia Aboriginal People make up 3.1%<sup>1</sup> of the population, however Aboriginal People made up **7.05%** of hospitalisations due to **road trauma** between 2011-2015.
